- 1. Any felony.

- i. The continuation of any grossly socially unacceptable activity as judged by any of the people participating in the activity.
- The threat of bodily damage to anyone or the use of force. These actions should be judged by the board. Any complaints must be preceded by a written statement from a member. The statement should contain the names of the specific people involved and the circumstances. The offending party will be notified and given adequate time (30 days) to reply to the charge.
